Step 1

Fill-out **ALL** in-country information **prior** to departure:

- **In-country contacts are the most effective at helping in case of emergency**
- [911 equivalents](#)
- [US Embassy](#) contact information. Type in your country of travel
- [Global Gateway](#) contact information
- [ND Alumni](#) information
- [International calling](#) guidelines for exit codes. Often you can dial “+” from a cell phone

Step 2

Make sure you know your insurance information:

- If you have ND health insurance, review [ND HR Guide](#).
- **If you have other health insurance contact your provider before travel**
- ALL ND affiliates have evacuation insurance and travel assistance when on official ND business.

Step 3

Have the **iND**Case card on hand in multiple formats:

- Print several copies of the card (one for each bag, each wallet) – in case your phone becomes non-operational
- Save a picture of the card in your phone
- Save the phone numbers in your contacts
- **Share a completed card with a trusted person**
- Save the card in your email
