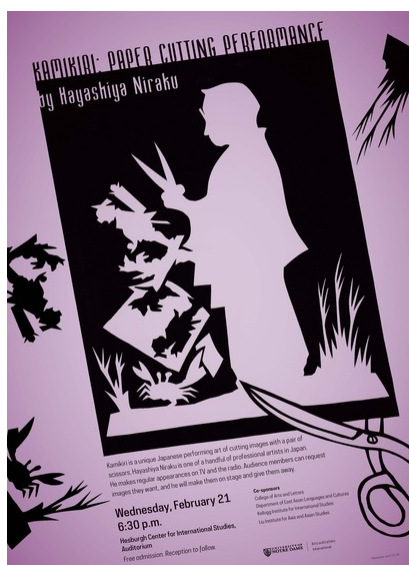
NDChallenge Suggestion: Attend Mass & Experience a Dorm Tradition!

The Kamikiri Japanese Paper Cutting Performance

Kamikiri, which literally means "paper cutting," is a traditional Japanese art that involves making delicate cutouts on a single sheet of paper. Hayashiya Niraku combines this art form with his performance skills to tell stories with the images he creates. He also takes requests from the audience, transforming their ideas into paper cut-outs right before their eyes and giving them unique souvenirs of the experience.
